FAQs about the Fireworks event on July 4th.

- 1. Is there a rain date?** NO, the fireworks can shoot in the rain, but not in unsafe weather conditions, some of the activities and music might not be available if it is raining. If unsafe weather conditions are in the area we will update any changes on all our social media outlets.
- 2. Where is Handicap parking?** Handicap parking is in the parking lot at the Bartlett Performing Arts Center. Enter off of Summer/HWY 70. You must have a handicap tag to enter.
- 3. Where can I park?** Parking is available in the parking lots of the BRC, the soccer field behind the BRC and the back parking lot of Appling Middle School until those lots are full. After that you can park in the surrounding neighborhoods but please do not block any driveways. NO parking on HWY 70.
- 4. Are dogs allowed?** We highly recommend that you leave your dogs at home but if they do join you, you will need to have them on a leash and pick up after them.
- 5. Are coolers & an outside food allowed?** YES, but remember no alcohol is allowed at City of Bartlett events. There will be a variety of concession vendors at the event. You are welcome to bring your own food, drinks & snacks.
- 6. Can I sit up a tent?** NO, but you can bring lawn chairs, blankets, and small umbrellas.

- 7. Can I ride my bike or golf cart to the event?** Riding your bike to the event is a great idea, but once you are inside the area we ask that you walk it through the crowd because of the number of people in the area. Also, NO skateboards are allowed in the area. If you come to the event in a golf cart you will have to park it outside of the event area.
- 8. Will there be activities for Children this year?** YES, there will be inflatables & games. A small fee will be charged for some of the activities. In case of rain, these activities might not be available.
- 9. Can I get a pass to be a part of the “Show & Shine” car display the day of the event?** NO, only a limited number were given out before the event.
- 10. Can my group or organization sell or solicited information?** NO, outside vendors are not allowed at this event, we have the Bartlett Festival in the fall for outside vendors. We limit this event to the American Legion, our concession vendors and the city sponsored activities that are provided.. If you want to hand our information, we can't stop you from walking the crowd and doing that, but keep in mind that a lot of those materials go in the trash. The best way to get your message out is wear a shirt with your name on it. More people will probably read your shirt than any materials you have given them.
- 11. If you need Police or Medical assistance,** there will be a mobile command unit set up by the parking lot at BPACC, along with numerous Police officers and Firefighters on site. The non-emergency number for Dispatch is 901-385-5555; in case of an emergency call 911.
