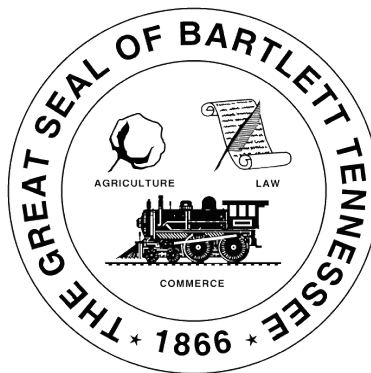

INTENT

The intent of these specifications is to provide sufficient specified information to permit prospective bidders to submit proposals for the provision of **Public Safety Security Camera (PSSC) Systems**. The awarded supplier will be required to deliver and install the equipment at various locations in Bartlett, Tennessee.

STATEMENT OF INTENT – EQUALITY AND FAIRNESS

The City of Bartlett will not discriminate against any individual for any reason and will provide services to all citizens in a nondiscriminatory fashion. It is the intent of the city to fully comply with the provision of Title VI and Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. The City is committed to a moral, ethical, and legal responsibility to ensure equitable employment practices and the delivery of city services regardless of an individual's race, color, religion, national origin, age, disability, gender, or political affiliation.

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

These specifications are intended as minimum requirements. However, it is recognized that each manufacturer has special features that make its equipment unique. Therefore, all bids will be considered, but every bidder must state, in detail, where their product fails to meet these specifications. It is the intention of the City to purchase quality products and not necessarily the products with the lowest initial cost. The City will evaluate each bid in terms of initial cost, delivery date, service and the availability of replacement parts, resale value, and the terms of the warranty.

1. All bidders must clearly identify any and all deviations from these specifications that their products may have; however, bids must meet or exceed specifications.
2. Bidder shall include the Cost Proposal Table, Bid Specification form, Proposed Item Description form, as well as the signed and notarized Iran Divestment Act form & Public Acts form. Note: An original, clearly marked, and two copies shall be included.
3. Bidder must include a current year, signed W-9 form.
4. All prices are to be firm for **180** days from the bid due date.
5. All prices must be equal to or less than the pricing available to the general public to be considered.
6. The bid should state the manufacturer's warranty, along with the owner's manuals.
7. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
8. An Award Letter will be issued to the successful vendor designating them the supplier of said equipment for the period specified in the Bid-Pricing Guarantee (180 or 365 days from the bid due date).
9. An official Purchase Order may be issued for one (1) unit, multiple units, or zero (0) units at any time during the awarded period. All purchase orders are subject to available funding.
10. Equipment delivered because of the award of this bid shall be a current-year model, new and unused.
11. All charges for transportation and unloading are to be pre-paid by the successful bidder and are not the responsibility of the City of Bartlett.

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DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS

1.1 Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this Request for Sealed Bids is to define the City's minimum requirements, solicit bids, and gain adequate information by which the City may evaluate the services offered by Proposers.

The City of Bartlett, Tennessee, located in Shelby County, Tennessee, hereinafter referred to as the City, intends to secure a contract for the purchase of Public Safety Security Camera (PSSC) Systems with accompanying warranty and maintenance agreements if applicable. Special consideration may be given to proposers that can expedite the delivery and installation of the cameras and systems.

1.2 Scope of Services

The Bartlett Police Department (BPD) is soliciting proposals for the purchase of stationary camera systems to include all hardware, software, and all other necessary items for a fully functional Public Safety Security Camera (PSSC) System. The PSSC Systems would include the cameras and all its hardware, as well as, storage and management software, installation as needed, training, maintenance, and support and warranty. The System must meet or exceed the requirements as detailed in Section 1.3.

1.3 Project Intent

It is the intent of the Bartlett Police Department to deploy public safety security camera systems in strategic locations throughout the City of Bartlett. These systems will be designed to allow for live-view monitoring, recorded surveillance, and integrated automated license plate reader (ALPR) software. These systems will be attached to existing utility poles, or similar, and utilize a streetlight photocell power tap.

At each dedicated location, at least one primary system will be deployed. The primary system will contain the computer and communications hardware necessary to process the video and output the data over a cellular network. Every primary system must be able to provide a live stream view of each camera via a Real Time Streaming Protocol (RTSP) or similar. At certain locations, secondary systems will be deployed in tandem with the primary system. The secondary systems will be responsible for transmitting its live video feed to the primary system over a point-to-point wireless bridge.

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Each primary and secondary system will be equipped with at least one network bullet camera capable of clearly capturing vehicle license plates at speeds up to 60 MPH. Based on the location, a variety of additional network cameras may be added to either system. Each primary system should be capable of processing up to three (3) live video feeds, including any video feeds from secondary systems.

The City of Bartlett will provide SIM cards for the systems' communication needs and will be responsible for any charges and fees associated with the cellular network.

1.4 Public Safety Security Camera System Specifications

1.4.1 General System Specifications

- A. The City expects to deploy approximately thirty (30) Public Safety Security Camera Systems in various locations throughout the City.
- B. The public safety security camera systems will consist of two (2) separate models capable of working in tandem with one another; Primary System and Secondary System.
- C. Each system shall consist of a heavy-duty weatherproof, rugged, and vented enclosure allowing for operation in wet and extreme conditions and provided in a neutral color, such as white, so the unit is not conspicuous.
- D. Each system shall be finished with an anti-corrosion powder coating.
- E. Each system shall have the ability to be mounted to an existing pole, or similar structure.
- F. Each system shall have the ability to operate off an 110V power source.
- G. Each system must be capable of simultaneously housing and supporting multiple network cameras.
- H. Fuse breaker to protect electronics.

1.4.2 Network Camera Requirements

All cameras must comply with section 889 of the 2022 NDAA.

1.4.3 Primary System Specifications

- A. The Primary System shall meet all specifications outlined in Section 1.4.1.
- B. The Primary System shall contain an on-board industrial rated computer meeting the following minimum requirements:
 - i. Twelve (12) core CPU capable of up to 4.40 GHz and 16 MB cache.
 - ii. 1 TB of Storage capability.
 - iii. Microsoft Windows 10, or newer, operating system.
 - iv. Remote access to system from any location.
 - v. Video Management Systems allowing for the capture, recording, storing, retrieving, viewing, and analyzing video collected from remote wireless devices.
 - vi. Video Management System allowing for the LIVE viewing of video from remote wireless devices.
 - vii. Video Management System annual licensing fee is free.
- C. The Primary System shall contain a POE switch capable of controlling up to three (3) network cameras.
- D. The Primary System shall contain a Cradlepoint IBR 900 Series Ruggedized Industrial-Grade LTE/ Router – FirstNet Ready.
- E. External High Gain Omnidirectional Antenna with GPS.

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- F. Each Primary System shall have the ability to house up to three (3) network cameras.
- G. Each Primary System must be capable of installing a point-to-point wireless bridge receiver capable of processing data at a rate of 500Mbps or higher.
- H. The Primary System shall be equipped with an Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) Battery Backup.

1.4.4 Secondary System Specifications

- A. The Secondary System shall meet all specifications outlined in Section 1.4.1.
- B. The Secondary System shall be equipped with a point-to-point wireless bridge transmitter capable of transmitting data at a rate of 500Mbps or higher.

***It should be noted that, for every Secondary System, the accompanying point-to-point wireless bridge receiver will be equipped on a Primary System.**

The unit price of the Secondary System indicated on the Cost Proposal, Attachment 2.1, Item 2, should include the installation of the point-to-point wireless bridge receiver on the accompanying Primary System.

- C. The Secondary System shall contain a POE switch capable of controlling up to three (3) network cameras.
- D. The Primary System shall be equipped with an Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) Battery Backup.

1.5 Automated License Plate Recognition (ALPR) Software

It is the intent of the Bartlett Police Department to run certain live video feeds through Automated License Plate Recognition (ALPR) Software. The preferred software for this application is the Rekor Scout Agent ALPR Software. This software will be installed on each of the Primary Systems' computers. This ALPR Software will analyze the live video feeds in real time and upload the data into the Rekor Database for investigative purposes. The Rekor Scout Agent download is free. The Vendor will be responsible for procuring the Rekor licensing for each live video stream run through the ALPR Software. Each live video stream run through the ALPR Software must have its own license. The vendor should provide a set cost for each license for a period of one (1) year, two (2) years, and three (3) years. The specific number of years purchased, if any, will be determined by the city at a later date. The cost for each license should be included in the Cost Proposal Table (Attachment 2.1). The cost provided by the vendor should be reasonable and consistent with fair market values.

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1.6 Warranty

The Vendor agrees to warrant all system components outlined in **Section 1.4** for five (5) years from the installation date. During the five-year warranty period, the vendor agrees to handle any and all manufacturer warranty claims, including, but not limited to, removal, shipping, replacement, and installation of any component covered by a manufacturer's warranty. The vendor will be responsible for maintaining and servicing each system during the five-year warranty period and ensuring that each system is operating effectively and efficiently. If the vendor is unable to provide said five (5) year warranty, the vendor must specify in detail what warranties may exist and will be provided to the customer in Attachment 2.3.

1.7 Proposed Cost Model

Each proposed cost entered in the Cost Proposal Table (Attachment 2.1), should be per unit and be an all-inclusive cost of the following items. Each item must meet or exceed the specifications outlined in Section 1.4.
